

WEBSITE PRIVACY POLICY

Effective November 29 2023

Welcome to the Privacy Policy of Elevate Staffing.

We respect and value your privacy. This Privacy Policy (“Policy”) describes how we collect, use, and disclose information we collect from you through our website (the “Site”). Elevate Staffing owns and operates this Site. References in this Policy to “Elevate,” “we,” “our,” “us,” or “the Company” mean Elevate Staffing [and its subsidiaries and affiliates].

Please read this Policy carefully. If you do not agree with any term in this Policy, please do not use the Site and refrain from providing any personal information to us. By using the Site and providing your personal information voluntarily through the Site will constitute your acceptance of this Policy and your consent for us to process your information as disclosed here.

This Site is intended for those who are at least 18 years old. Please do not use the Site or provide any personal information to us if you are not yet 18 years old.

I. WHAT PERSONAL INFORMATION DO WE COLLECT

Personal Information or **Personal Data** means information that identifies, describes or is directly or indirectly related to an individual or a household, or that is reasonably capable of being associated with a particular individual or household. Personal information does not include protected health information as defined by the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA), or information subject to the Fair Credit Reporting Act. This also does not include anonymous data, or information that can’t be linked to a person because the identifying elements have been removed.

We may collect, use, store and transfer the following categories of Personal Information about you, which we have grouped together as follows:

- **Identifiers** including first name, last name, username or other similar identifier, nickname, date of birth, place of birth and gender; postal address, email address and telephone numbers; Internet Protocol (IP) address, your login data including your username and password,
- **Geolocation data**, including your general location from which you access the Site.
- **Internet or other similar network, browsing, or search activity** including your interactions with the Site such as your search history.
- **Professional or employment-related information** including your company affiliation, education, training, certifications, languages, resume, references, and work experience.
- **Communications** including the contents and metadata of our communications with you by email, text message (SMS or MMS), telephone call and our communications with you by mail.

- **Cal. Civ. Code § 1798.80 personal records information** to the extent not already included in the other categories listed here.
- **Sensitive Personal Information:**
 - Racial or ethnic origin

Our use of Sensitive Personal Information. We only use the sensitive personal information that we collect as necessary to perform the services the average person would reasonably expect when requesting those services or for legal compliance purposes. We limit the use of Sensitive Personal Information to detecting security incidents, to maintaining the quality of our services, or for other purposes not granted the right to opt out under the California Consumer Privacy Act. Elevate does not infer characteristics from the sensitive personal information that we collect.

II. WHAT NON-IDENTIFYING INFORMATION DO WE COLLECT

We also may collect, use, store and transfer the following types of non-identifying information:

- **Technical Data** including Internet Protocol (IP) address, your login data, browser type and version, time zone setting and location, browser plug-in types and versions, operating system and platform, and other technologies on the devices you use to access this Site.
- **Usage Data** including information about how you use our Site.
- **Aggregated Data and De-identified Data**, such as statistical or demographic data, for any purpose. Aggregated Data may be derived from your personal information but is not considered personal information within the meaning of the law, as it does not directly or indirectly identify you. For example, we may aggregate your Usage Data to calculate the share of users accessing a specific feature of the Site. However, if we combine or connect the Aggregated Data with your personal information so that it can directly or indirectly identify you, we treat the combined data as personal information that will be used in accordance with this Privacy Policy.

III. SOURCES FROM WHICH WE COLLECT YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION

- **Direct interactions with you.** You may provide us with your personal information by filling in forms or corresponding with us, through the Site, by mail, telephone, email correspondence or otherwise. This includes personal information you provide when you:
 - Contact us through the Site;
 - apply for a job posted by us;

- request that marketing actions or communications be sent to you; or
 - give us your opinion or contact us.
- **Service Providers.** We may collect personal information about you from our service providers, including our HR hiring platform provider.
 - **Automated technologies or interactions.** When you interact with our Site, we automatically collect Usage Data and Technical Data about your equipment, actions and browsing habits. We collect this personal data using cookies and other similar technologies. **COOKIES** are small text files placed on your device that uniquely identify your device and which a website can transfer to a user's hard drive to keep records of his or her visits to a website. We, or third parties, may use session cookies or persistent cookies. Session cookies only last for the specific duration of your visit and are deleted when you close your browser. Persistent cookies remain on your device's hard drive until you delete them or they expire. Both types of cookies enhance your user experience by recalling your use of the Internet and our Site. We will treat this data as personal information only where the data, or the information it is associated with, can be individually identified to you or your device. Please see our [cookie policy](#) for more details about the specific cookies that we use and ways to manage cookies. Please note that if you reject cookies, you may still use our Site, but your ability to use some features or areas of the Site may be limited.
 - **MS Clarity and Google Analytics.** We use third party analytics tools to help us understand the users of the Site. These tools use cookies to collect non-personal information including usage information and navigational information. The analytics tools provide us with aggregated data about the Site's traffic and interactions, enabling us to improve the Site experience.

IV. HOW WE USE YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION

We will only use your personal information to the extent permitted by law. Most often, we will use your personal data in the following circumstances:

- When we obtain your consent.
- Where it is necessary for a business purpose, such as to fulfill your request.
- When we need to comply with a legal obligation to which we are subject.
- When it is necessary for us to exercise and enforce our rights or in defense of legal claims.

Purposes for which we will use your personal information

We have set out in the table below the business and commercial purposes for which we may use your personal information, and the categories of personal

information that may be processed for that purpose. We may use certain categories of your personal information for multiple purposes.

Please contact us if you need details of the specific circumstance and business or commercial purposes process your personal data.

Limitation or Change of Purpose

We will only use your personal information for the purposes for which we collected it or another purpose which we disclose to you that is compatible with the original purpose. If you would like an explanation of the compatibility of the processing for the new purpose with the original purpose, please contact us.

If we need to use your personal data for incompatible purposes, we will notify you to either get your consent or to explain the legal basis that allows us to do so.

Please note that if we are required to or permitted by law, we may process your personal information without your knowledge or consent, in accordance with the above rules.

V. Disclosure of your personal data

We may share your personal data with the parties mentioned below for the purposes set out in the table above and other purposes as set forth in this section.

- Service providers and Contractors, including those who provide IT services in connection with with the Site or providers of professional services, including lawyers, bankers, auditors, accountants and insurers, who provide consulting, banking, legal, insurance and accounting services.
- Our affiliated companies

We do not allow our third-party service providers to use your personal data for their own purposes and only allow them to process your personal data for specific purposes and in accordance with our instructions. We require all third parties to implement and maintain commercially reasonable technical, organizational, and administrative measures to protect the security of your personal information and to treat it in accordance with the law.

In the event of a merger or sale of business or assets, we may disclose your personal information to third parties to whom we may choose to sell, transfer or merge a portion of our business or assets. We may also seek to acquire or merge with other businesses. If there is a change in our business, the new owners will be able to use your personal data in the same way as set out in this privacy policy. If the new owners collect and/or use your personal data in a different way, you will be notified of the change.

We may disclose your personal information if we are required to do so by law enforcement, or if we are otherwise under a legal obligation to make the disclosure. We may also disclose personal information if it is necessary to comply with the law or to protect the rights, property, and safety of Elevate, our users, and others.

VI. Personal Information Sales and Sharing

Elevate does not Sell or Share your personal information as those terms are defined under applicable privacy laws.

VII. International transfers of your personal information

Elevate and its affiliates operate in the US, Canada, and Europe, and we serve end clients worldwide. Occasionally we may need to provide access to or transfer your personal information outside of the country where it was originally provided to and/or collected by us.

Transfers out of the EU. Whenever we transfer your personal information outside the European Union, we ensure that a similar level of protection is afforded to it by ensuring that at least one of the following safeguards is implemented: (1) we will only transfer your personal data to countries that have been considered to offer

an adequate level of protection for personal information; or (2) when we use certain service providers, we may use standard contractual clauses that give personal data the same protection as it enjoys in the European Union.

Please contact us if you would like further information about the protections we use when transferring your personal information out of the country where it was collected.

VIII. SECURITY

We take commercially reasonable, industry-standard measures to secure your personal information from accidental loss and from unauthorized access, use, alteration, and disclosure. Your Personal Information is contained behind secured networks and is only accessible by a limited number of authorized personnel and service providers who have special access rights in order to do their jobs and are required to keep the information confidential. We work to protect the security of your information during transmission by using Secure Sockets Layer (SSL) software, which encrypts information you input.

Please keep in mind that no security measures can guarantee the complete safety of your Personal Information. Whenever you give out information online there is a risk that third parties may intercept and use that information. As a result, we cannot guarantee the security of any information you disclose online and you do so at your own risk. You should exercise caution when deciding to disclose or share your personal or other information.

IX. How long do we retain your personal information?

Unless stated otherwise, we will only retain your personal information for as long as reasonably necessary to fulfil the purposes for which we collected it, including to meet any legal, regulatory, tax, accounting or reporting requirements. We may retain your personal information for a longer period in the event of a complaint or if we reasonably believe that there is a prospect of litigation concerning our relationship.

To determine the appropriate retention period for personal information, we consider the amount, nature and sensitivity of the personal information, the potential risk of harm from unauthorized use or disclosure of your personal data, the purposes for which we process your personal information and whether we can achieve those purposes by other means, as well as applicable legal, regulatory, tax, accounting or other obligations.

The retention periods for cookies or other identifiers are detailed in the Cookie Policy.

If you apply for a job that is posted by us, we will retain the personal information that you provide for up to 24 months. If we enter into an employment relationship with you, the data will be retained for five (5) years after the end of your employment relationship, unless applicable law provides otherwise.

In certain circumstances, we will anonymize or de-identify your personal data (so that it cannot reasonably be expected to identify you) for research or statistical

purposes, in which case we may use this information indefinitely without notifying you.

X. YOUR PRIVACY RIGHTS

You may choose to withdraw your consent and opt out of receiving any promotional or marketing emails or newsletters from us. To unsubscribe from our email list, please follow the link to unsubscribe that is included in the email; or you may contact us at 1crm-us@weareelevate.global to exercise your right to opt out. We will respond to your request within a reasonable time after receiving your request. Please note that you will not be able to opt-out of necessary communications related to your job assignments.

You have the right to request that we correct or modify the personal information that we collect about you. We encourage you to update your Personal Information promptly if it changes. You may contact us at hr@weareelevate.global to exercise your right to correct or modify your Personal Information. We take reasonable steps to ensure that your Personal Information is accurate and kept up to date.

PRIVACY RIGHTS FOR CALIFORNIA RESIDENTS

You have various rights under Data Protection Laws, subject to certain exemptions, in connection with our processing of your personal data, including those set out in the table below.

Data Protection Right	Explanation
Right to Know	You have the right to know whether we collected, sold, shared, or disclosed for a business purpose the personal information we collected from you. You may request that we disclose to you (1) the categories of personal information we have collected about you; (2) the categories of sources from which that personal information is collected; (3) the business or commercial purpose for collecting, selling or sharing the personal information; (4) the categories of third parties to whom we disclosed personal information; (5) the categories of personal information that we sold, and for each category identified, the categories of third parties to which we sold that particular category of personal information; and (6) the categories of personal information that we sold, and for each category identified, the categories of



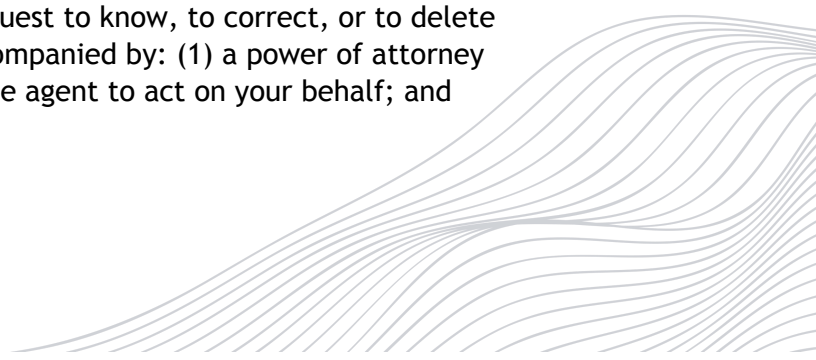
	third parties to which we sold that particular category of personal information.
Right to Correct	You may request to have inaccurate or incomplete information corrected and updated by us. You may also correct or modify your personal information by visiting your account.
Right to Delete	This right enables you to ask us to delete or remove personal information where there is no good reason for us continuing to process it. You also have the right to ask us to delete or remove your personal data where you have exercised your right to object to processing. However, where we hold and process your personal data in order to comply with legal obligations, such as compliance with laws, or for the establishment, exercise or defense of legal claims, your right to ask us to delete or remove your personal information is limited.
Data Portability Right	You have the right to request specific pieces of personal information we collected about you, and, to request, where technically feasible, to that we provide your personal information in a readily usable format to be transmitted to another business.
Right to Non-discrimination	You have the right not to be discriminated against just because you have exercised any of the above consumer rights.

HOW TO EXERCISE YOUR RIGHTS:

You may exercise any of your rights by submitting a request to 1crm-us@weareelevate.global or through the [form available](#) or calling us at 800-850-6745. Please be aware that we may need to ask you to provide a few pieces of personal information that we can use to match against our records to verify your identity. We may not be able to act on your request should you decline to provide the verifying details.

If you are a California resident, you may be able to exercise your rights through the assistance of an authorized agent, as defined by the California Consumer Privacy Act. We must verify the authorized agent’s authority to act on your behalf prior to addressing your request.

Where the authorized agent is submitting a request to know, to correct, or to delete personal information, the request must be accompanied by: (1) a power of attorney that is valid under California law authorizing the agent to act on your behalf; and (2) verification of your own identity with us.



Where the authorized agent is submitting a request to opt-out of Sales or Sharing, the request must be supported by a signed permission demonstrating that the agent is authorized by you to act on your behalf.

XI. UPDATING YOUR PERSONAL DATA

We encourage you to keep your personal information accurate and up to date. You are responsible for notifying us of any changes to your personal information that you provide to us.

XII. SHINE THE LIGHT REQUESTS.

If you are a California resident, California law allows you to request that we tell you what categories of Personal Information we disclosed to third parties for their direct marketing purposes in the previous twelve (12) months, and to whom we disclosed them. XIII. DO NOT TRACK DISCLOSURE.

Some internet browsers include the ability to transmit “Do Not Track” signals. While we do not track IP addresses and where users come from or navigate to, we do not currently process or respond to “Do Not Track” signals. XIV. INFORMATION ABOUT MINORS

Our Site and services are not directed at minors, and we do not knowingly collect personal information from minors.
